We operate as an integrated sourcing, grading, processing and export partner — working directly with farmer collectives and regulated mandis to assemble container-ready volumes without compromising on traceability or quality.

Every consignment is graded, moisture-tested and packed to the specification of the destination market — from jute bags for bulk turmeric to retail-ready vacuum packs for supermarket chains in Singapore and Australia.

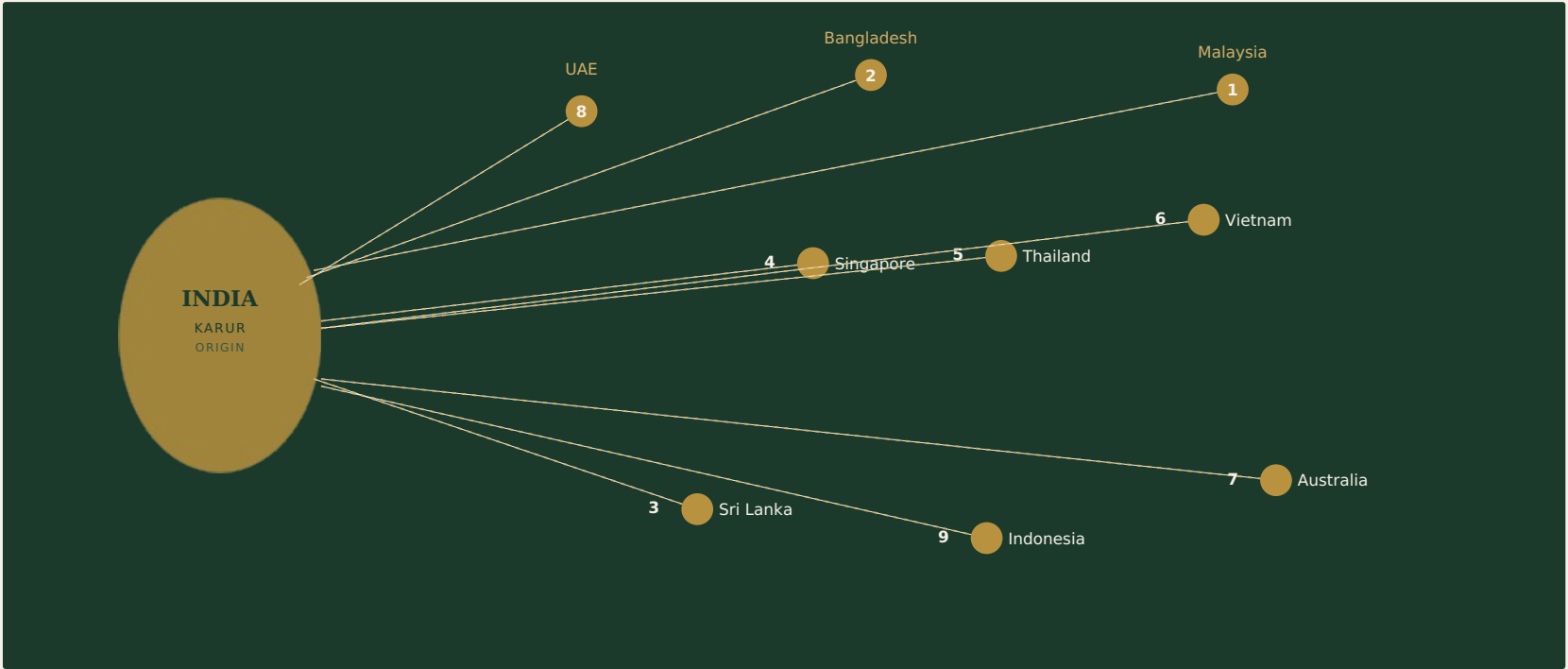

Onion

South India's red and rose onions — prized for pungency, firm bite and extended shelf life across retail, food-service and processing markets.

Maharashtra (Nashik belt), Karnataka (Bangalore Rose) & Tamil Nadu growing clusters — consolidated through Karur.

SHELF LIFE
4–6 months under ventilated storage; 8–10 months for cured shallots.

STORAGE CONDITIONS
Cool, dry, well-ventilated environment, 4–10°C, relative humidity 65–70%. Avoid moisture exposure during transit.

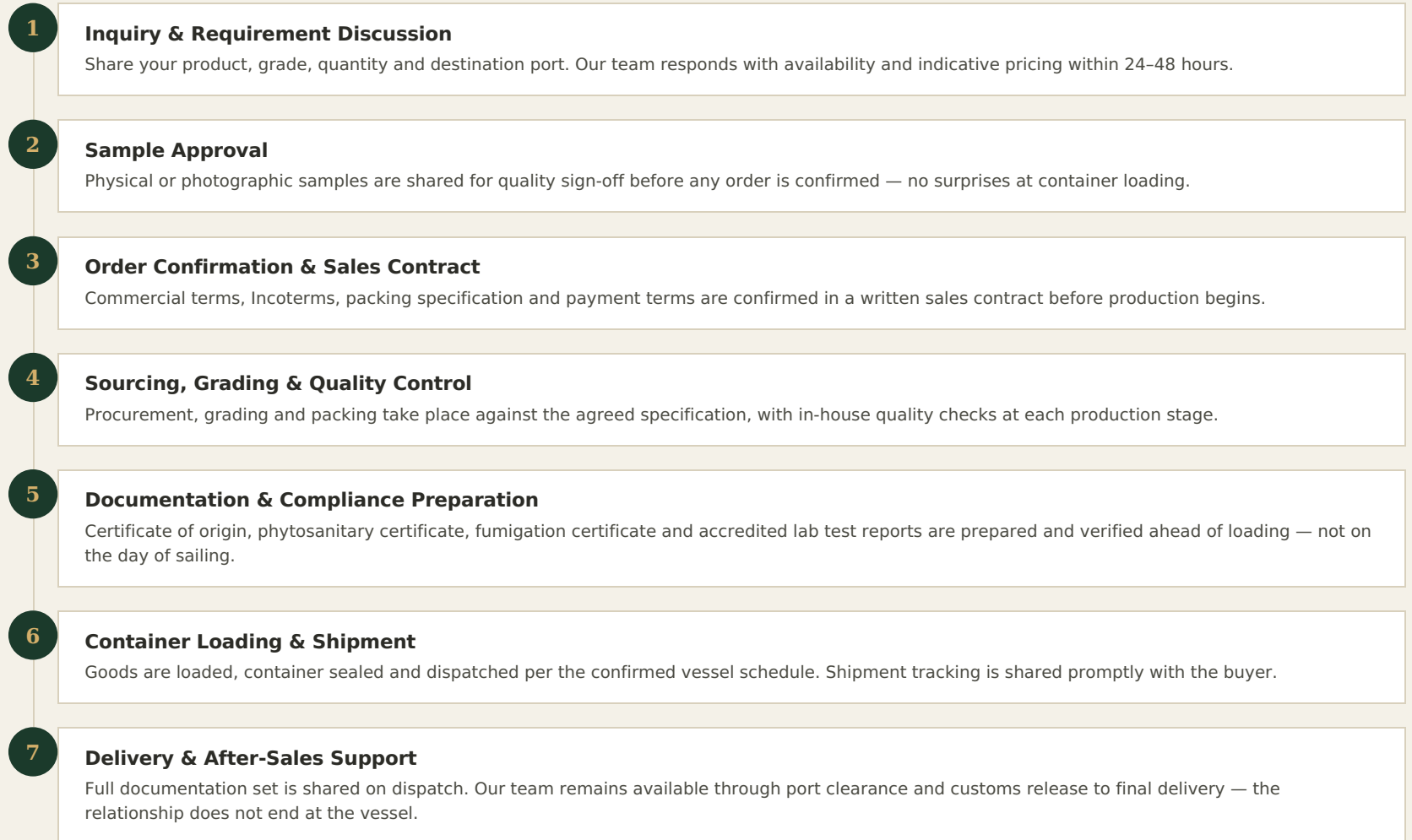
